FROM THE CHAIRMAN'S DESK



Dear Friends,

I have great pleasure to welcome you to our 16th AGM. Constructive & positive efforts from all member industries in their individual ETP plant has reduced load on CETP and due to proper operations and excellent management of CETP by their executive committee members and staff has helped to achieve best performance of our CETP.

Since last three years CETP Executive committee worked hard to implement- Quality management system, best environment practices and health & safety practices for enhancing overall performance of CETP. First surveillance IMS audit was quite satisfactory with Zero NC. From 30th June 2015 we are directly connected to MPCB and CPCB portal through online monitoring system for close monitoring of CETP performance and noticed zero deviations in MPCB consent parameters. *Mahad CETP is first CETP in INDIA to qualify for IMS certification. Due to best performance of our CETP all Industries in Mahad industrial area are getting easy permissions for expansion. This is all because of consistent performance of CETP & complying with MPCB norms.*

"In order to maintain consistent performance of CETP all industries have to meet 100% consistent MPCB norms. As per resent proposal by CPCB to NITI Aayog failing to meet consent norms may result in heavy penalties up to 5 Crores with 7 years' imprisonment and in case of heavy damage to environment or resources penalty may increase up to 20 Crores with life time imprisonment for units."

Looking towards growth of existing units and upcoming units in Mahad industrial area EC committee is working on proposal to upgrade existing CETP and also expansion of CETP to accommodate additional effluent load. For this up gradation and expansion of CETP existing and new units needs to pay in proportion of their increased hydraulic load.

Apart from its core activity of effluent treatment, as a part of CSR -MMA CETP has taken great initiative in educational, health and many other social activities for weaker sector of society. From 1st August 2015 MMA CETP in coordination with SATYA SAI SEVA TRUST has started its Free Mobile Hospital service to needy residents of all Villages including Adivasi areas in Mahad Taluka and till date covered more than 25000 patients by providing free health checkup and free medicines. (Dispensary Mobile Van provide by Mallak Specialties P.Ltd.). In Joint venture with Sanjeevani Pratishthan MMA CETP and industries has started first Cardiac Van in Raigad District. Various industries and associations provided great physical and financial help during rescue operation on 2nd August 2016 while collapse of Savitri Bridge.

6. COURT CASES:

- 1. In respect of M/s. Embio Ltd. outstanding dues, we have filled the writ petition revision application before the Hon'ble High Court Mumbai. Case is under process.
- 2. M/s.Embio Ltd. has also filled the case before Hon'ble District Co-Operative Court Alibag against the Sub Registrar Mahad has passed the order for recovery. Case is under process.
- 3. In the case of public litigation (pil-17.2011) raised by the Nicholas H. Almeida before the Bombay high court for River pollution against state government of Maharashtra in this case we are the one of the respondents in that case & the case has been disposed by Hon'ble High Court Mumbai dated 18.04.2016.

7. CONTINGENT LIABILITIES:

There is a claim of contingent nature liabilities against the Bank Guarantee of 5.00 Lacs for establishment, development and maintaining of CETP website for displaying information about CETP performance& Bank Guarantee of 10.00 Lacs for Operation & Maintenance as per the consent condition.

8. CONSENT TO OPERATE:

As per statuary requirement we have applied CETP Consent for renewal dated 24/03/2017 to MPCB head office and as per requirement we have paid fees of amount Rs. 265000/- for five years and it is in process.

9. PROVISIONS FOR INCOME TAX:

The society has made provision for income tax in respect of AY 2011-12 of Rs. 13,21,280/- as per appeal order passed by DCIT, Panvel on 15.03.2017. The Society has received appeal order in

respect of AY 2010-11 and also notice u/s 148 of Income Tax Act, 1961 received to the society and accordingly return of income against the said notice is filled with the concerned authority. Till the date of audit the order for the return filed is not received hence the no provision for appellate order is made during the year.

Provision made for income tax for F.Y. 2016-17. The Society has been formed with the object of providing treatment of effluents for its members. The moneys required for the treatment have been contributed by the members and none other than the members. No income (except Interest on Investment & sale of scrap) has been generated out of dealing with any third party.

The entire contribution has originated from its members and has been expended on furtherance of the activity for which the moneys have been contributed and for the benefit of the members under the mutuality concept, provision for income tax not made expect provision on interest received on investment of Rs. 47983/-

10. BILLING SYSTEM FORMULA FOR TREATMENT CHARGES:

All General Body Members have agreed unanimously passed resolution in the EGM held on 3rd October, 2012 w.e.f. August 2012 & resolution passed unanimously in the AGM held on 25th September, 2015 w.e.f. October, 2015.

If Industry fails to inform well in advance then penalty will be levied along with the charges as above mentioned rates along with penalty.

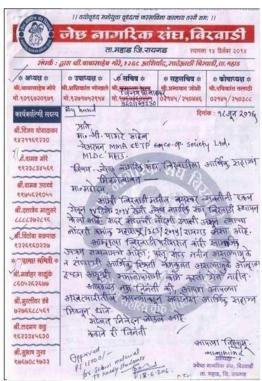


LED Projector for Digitalization of Z.P.School Aakale.

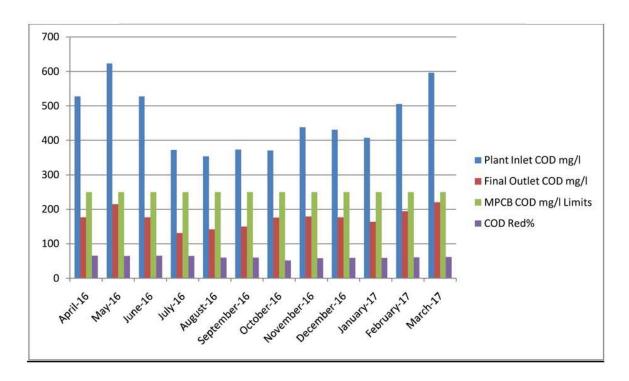
16. <u>VIGILANCE SAMPLING</u>:

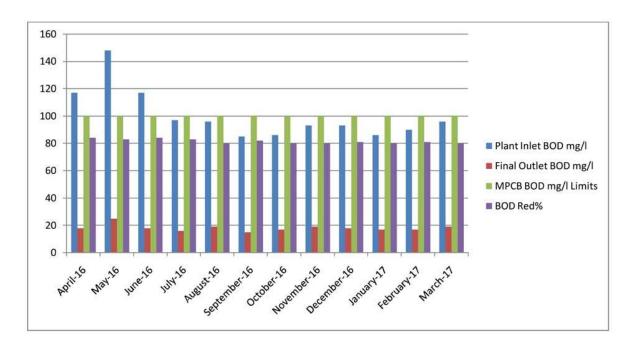

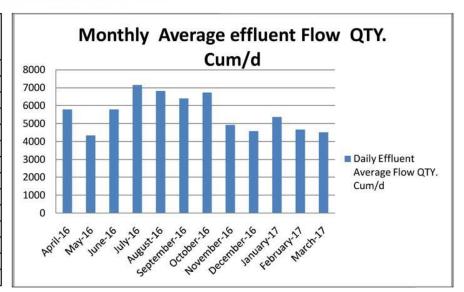

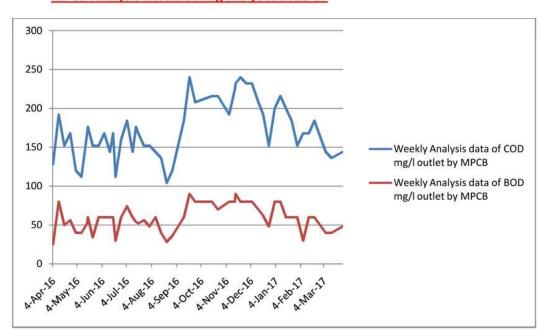

MMA CETP has maintained the Outlet COD below 250 mg/l and Outlet BOD below 100 mg/l as per the weekly joint venture sampling through out of year. (Not a single deviation to MPCB Norms during year 2016-17)

18. STATUS OF THE PLANT:

The Plant is in operation from last 13 years. The average effluent quantity treated is 5.50MLD. In the course of time, various modifications and additions were being carried out to improve the plant performance.

MIDC Infrastructure: Issues & Follow up

- Inadequate pumping system for disposal of effluent.
- Diffuser system is not installed at Ovale.
- Single effluent disposal line from Muthawali to Ovale, no parallel line is laid by MIDC, which is essential in case emergency. Even the existing pipe line is also weak and frequently leaking, causing serious trouble.
- Extension of pipe line up to Ambet Crick is long pending issue it is essential to extend pipe line up to Ambet as per original plan. (In deep sea).
- At least extension of existing pipe line up to 2.4 Km from Ovale as per NIO guide line must be done immediately.
- Storm water drain in the MIDC area- MIDC has to provide well planed storm water drainage line in all MIDC area.
- ➤ MIDC must take effective steps- To stop rain water ingracing into the MIDC effluent collection chamber to avoid possibility of overflow of inlet as well as discharge sump.

Up-gradation of plant:

CETP management has taken the following steps for efficiency improvement of treatment and maintaining the better environmental condition at all levels.

- Segregation of low COD effluent generating industries (Sudarshan, Laxmi, Ashok Alco) of 2.5 MLD and additional other industry in MIDC area & also industries from addl. MIDC area. It helps to increase the hydraulic retention time in biological treatment to get better COD reduction. Low COD sump construction work completed but not handed over by MIDC to CETP due to some leakages and repairing work.
 - CETP build up Pump house shed at low COD sump constructed by MIDC.
- ➤ Carry out treatability study & membrane technology study. Fixing of magnetic flow meter and online pH meter to inlet and outlet for better & effective treatment of effluent.
- Use of submersible sludge carrying pump to reduce sludge accumulation at the bottom of receiving sump which reduces heavy cost of accumulation sludge removal, handling and transportation after every 2 years.
- Reduce incoming COD load by member industries by systematic study of individual ETP of each member industry and by carry out stage wise sampling and giving valuable suggestion and technology to improve their ETP performance resulted in sizable reduction at source and inlet COD load of CETP.

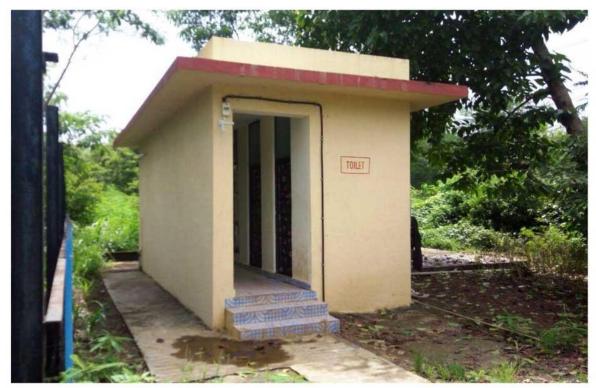

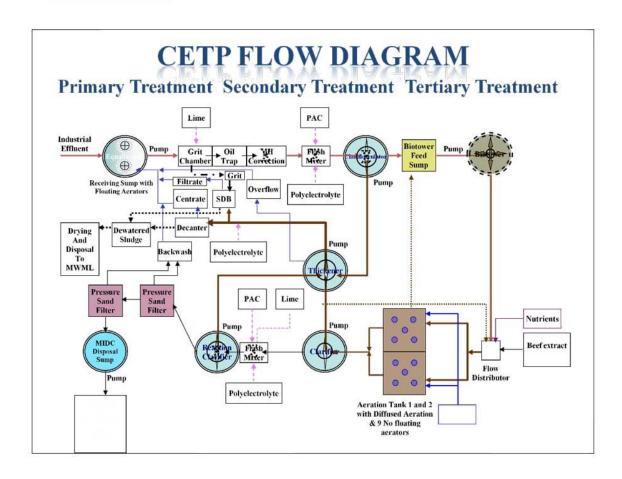
